The Toxicology Education Foundation announces the availability of the 2025 Robert L. Dixon International Travel Award, which is offered every three years. The 2025 award provides \$2,000 to enable the recipient to attend and present at the 17th International Congress of Toxicology in Beijing, China, from October 15-18, 2025.

The Award was established in memory of Robert L. Dixon as a tribute to his dedication to the field of toxicology and student training. Continuous contributions to TEF help to ensure funding for this award.

Eligibility Criteria

• Enrolled in full-time Ph.D. study in the area of reproductive/developmental toxicology.

Directions

- 1. All sections of the application form provided must be completed. Note: use only allotted spaces and a font of at least 10 points.
- 2. Your Research Director must complete the Reference Letter Form (page 3) with Letter of Recommendation, and mail directly to TEF at **dourson@tera.org**.
- 3. Include with the application a list of complete citations for your work and up to three reprints for which you are primary author and/or best represent your toxicological research.
- 4. The applicant will electronically send a complete set of the application, consisting of the following items:
 - a. Completed application, pages 1-2
 - b. Graduate transcript(s) (Copies of official transcript are acceptable.)
 - c. List of complete citations for your original work (abstracts, original articles, etc.)
 - d. Up to three reprints
 - e. Copy of the abstract submitted to the ICT XVII
